Based on MME forecast large deficit in rainfall is predicted from 28.2.25 to 6.3.25 and large excess in rainfall is predicted from 7.3.25 to 13.3.25. Based on MME forecast Tmax will be above normal in Week 1 and below normal in week 2. For Tmin, it will show below normal in Week 1 and week 2. Special advisory: Complete harvesting of potato. For increasing keeping quality potato should be store in the field by making heap. Always maintain a water level of two and half inch in boro paddy field. This should be followed for preventing node blast, neck blast, panicle blast and grain blast during extreme hot and dry weather of coming April month.

Always maintain a water level of two and half inch in boro paddy field for preventing node blast, neck blast, panicle blast and grain blast during extreme hot and dry weather of coming April month.

RICE	Boro paddy Peak Tillerring stageFungal and bacterial blast attack found due to large day night temperature differenceZinc deficiency (Symptom: Side of the leaf blade turn whitish and the tip portion turn into spring like structure) • Apply last top dressing with urea and potash • Maintain water level at least 2inch maintaining moist environment as weather is extreme dry. Otherwise due to extreme hot and dry weather during April may cause node blast, panicle blast and grain blast. • At booting stage before flower blooming apply one fungicide Tebuconazole or Kopiconazole grouped fungicide @0.6g per liter of water. Like Nativo, Koboz (Trade name) etc. • For healthy grain apply some Growth promoting hormone like Miraculam, Flora, Bumflower (Trade name) or MOP • Apply Chilated zinc spray @0.5ml per liter of water.		
GREEN GRAM	Green gram vegetative stage Spodoptera attack • Apply Spinosad 0.5ml per liter ,or Emamectin Benzoate ((Trade name: Proclaim)) during afternoon hours.		

#### **Horticulture Specific Advisory:**

Horticulture (Stage)	Horticulture Specific Advisory		
CUCUMBER	Cucurbits Flowering/ fruiting Downey mildew (burning symptom) • Apply Chlorothalonil (Trade name Koboch) @2g per liter of water. • Spraying must be done during afternoon hours.		
CHILLI	Chilli Flowering stage Leaf curl (Thrips attack) and Fruit borer attack at the stalk of flower • For leaf curl spray Flonicamid (Trade name: Ulala) and Thiamithoxon (Trade name: ektara) alternate spray 7 days interval • For fruit borer attack spray Spinosad 0.5ml per liter ,or Emamectin Benzoate (Trade name: Proclaim) afternoon hours.
