**Call for paper for poster presentation**

Abstract of original research work not exceeding 300 words (MS Word, strictly in Times New Roman 12 point font) must reach by email (secretarysfe@gmail.com; fhrahmancal@gmail.com; dsarkar04@rediffmail.com) to the Organizing Secretary, **not later than March 20, 2019.**

**Poster preparation**

The size of the poster shall be 75 cm × 100 cm briefly showing Title, Introduction, Methodology, Significant Findings (along with not more than three tables/figures/photographs) and bulleted Summary. The poster shall be made attractive, brief, where full sentences are not mandatory. It should be composed on a single sheet with appropriate colour scheme so that the content is readable from a distance of at least one meter. The poster display requires conforming to the above standards and pasting of several small pieces of black and white A4 papers should be avoided. One page handout (say 50 copies) on the poster may be brought for the desirous visitors. A soft copy of the poster is to be submitted to the organizer for making it accessible to the participants either through mail or available onsite in a CD during the Seminar.

The Kalyani city is well connected by rail as well as road and it is just 50 km away from Kolkata the capital of West Bengal. The participants can book their railway reservation either for Sealdah or Howrah and back. Those who are getting down at Howrah RS should come to Sealdah RS either by hired taxi or city bus and may avail local train service (one and half hour journey) towards Kalyani. They may also come to Bandel RS by local train (one hour) and may avail auto/mini bus service to reach FACC (Lake Hall), BCKV, Kalyani. City Taxi is available from Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose International Airport, Kolkata to Kalyani.
