Notice Inviting Tender for Export Testing Lab. (APEDA)

The Principal Investigator, Export Testing laboratory, Department of Agricultural Chemicals, Bidhan Chandra Krishi Viswavidyalaya, Mohanpur, Nadia is inviting quotation through e-tender from the entrepreneur/startup/ businessman/ individual/ group to provide Testing Services through Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode using the infrastructural facilities developed under Export Testing Laboratory (ETL) funded by APEDA, Govt. of India, Bidhan Chandra Krishi Viswavidyalaya, Mohanpur, Nadia.

- i. **Submission of e-tender:** The tender shall be submitted on line (<http://wbtenders.gov.in>) within 21 days of uploading in the e-tender portal.
- ii. **Opening of the tender:** The bid will be opened by the Central Tender Committee, BCKV.
- iii. The expected annual revenue from the operation of ETL under PPP mode is Rs. 12 Lakh per annum.
- iv. The interested Bidders will be allowed to visit and examine the Laboratory site and the infrastructural facilities available at BCKV, Mohanpur.
- v. The BCKV will provide the infrastructural facilities, viz. Laboratory space (5000sq.ft. Approx.); Furniture (**Annexure-I**). The BCKV will also provide the instruments funded by APEDA (**Annexure-II**). The successful bidder may carry out health check-up of those furniture and equipments on their own cost and may accept the items for day to day operation of the laboratory. The items for which repairing or up-gradation is not possible may be handed over to the BCKV authority. However, the custody of the remaining items will be handed over by the selected party to BCKV at the end of agreement period.
- vi. The BCKV will also take the responsibility for installation of a dedicated electric meter for the Laboratory building. However the cost of any load extension has to be borne by the selected party.
- vii. The BCKV will provide the No Objection certificate (NOC), if the selected private party needs Bank loan for the purpose of Procurement of the Instruments or other laboratory items and Repair/renovation of the laboratory. However the university will not act as guarantor for the loan.
- viii. The university will not be a guarantor for the manpower, if any, to be engaged by the selected agency. There will not be any employer-employee relation between the BCKV & employees of the private partne

- ix. At the time of handing over of the Export testing laboratory by the vendor to the University, the university will not be required to bear any cost for any development work undertaken by the selected agency during the lease period, and the agency will also not be allowed to alter the changes/up-gradation made by them during the contract period.
- x. The agency shall not transfer or sublet any part or entire premises of the above said demised premises (Export Testing Laboratory) to anyone else under any circumstances.
- xi. The agency shall have the right to remove any portable and removable thing, article/equipment, fittings brought by them into the premises and belonging to the vendor, without causing any structural damage to the building/ laboratory.
- xii. In the event the agency has upgraded or repaired any existing equipment/ machinery /instrument belonging to the University during the contract period, at the time of handing over of the export testing laboratory to the University the agency will not be allowed to remove any parts from the existing equipment/machinery belonging to the University.

***Technical requirement/ Selection Criteria for participation for PPP Mode:**

- i. The bidder with highest revenue offer per annum will be selected for the operation of ETL under PPP mode. However, there will be a minimum 15% hike of the annual revenue after every three years.
- ii. The interested bidders should have valid Trade license, PAN card, GST, P/Tax documents etc.
- iii. Repair & renovation of the existing laboratory building, electric connection, Payment of monthly electricity charge, water consumption charge, Procurement of new instruments, up-gradation /repair/ maintenance of the existing equipments, safety & security of the laboratory are some of the responsibilities of the selected party. However, the custody of the new instruments procured by the party within the agreement period will be handed over to the selected private party at the end of agreement period.
- iv. The duration of agreement will be initially for 10 years of which one year will be considered as start up period for repair-renovation of the building & instruments, procurement & installation of new instruments, and accreditation of the laboratory by NABL, FSSAI, and APEDA, etc.
- v. The annual revenue for the startup period i.e. for the 1st year will be exempted, but expenses like electricity charge and other related expenditures during the startup period are the responsibility of the selected party.
- vi. The cost in relation to the accreditation, certification, and business promotion will be borne by the private party. The testing services for export as well as for the domestic purpose are the sole responsibility of the selected private party.

vii. The selected private partner shall extend the testing services to the Department of Ag. Chemicals, BCKV for 350 numbers of samples for free of cost and 100 number of samples at 50% cost for other Departments of the University per annum under scope of the laboratory for conducting research work of the doctoral and master degree students.

Price bid of the vendors will be compared only if technical specificity is fulfilled. The Viswavidyalaya authority reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without showing any reason.

The bidders are also requested to submit the hard copy of the uploaded annexure-III at the end of bidding period.
