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NOTIFICATION

In view of the directives given by the State Government in respect of reopening of educational institutes (Colleges and Universities) of the State, vide Government Orders - No. 753/XII-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 29.10.2021, issued by the Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal, and No. 1058-Edn(CS)/10M-32/2021 dated 28.10.2021, issued by the Principal Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal, certain decisions were taken in meetings held on 01.11.2021 and 07.11.2021, held in the Chamber of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, BCKV.

In terms of the resolutions adopted in these two meetings, it is being notified as follows-

(1) The respective Deans, and the concerned teacher would be shouldering the responsibilities of each UG and PG hostels, as detailed below, as per the decision taken in the meeting held on 02.03.2021 in the Chamber of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, BCKV.

- (2) All girls hostels would be managed by lady Provosts and lady Stewards, and would be manned by lady supporting staff. The list of lady teaching and non-teaching members of staff, who have been assigned additional responsibilities of Provost and Steward, has been notified as per Notification No. REG/3/L-438 dated 08.11.2021.
- (3) The Deans of the three Faculties, the Dean, Post Graduate Studies, the Dean, Students' Welfare and the Registrar will coordinate all activities in respect of opening of students' hostels and resuming offline classes, with the assistance of the Works Department and the Medical Unit.
- (4) The same team, comprising of the Deans of the three Faculties, the Dean, Post Graduate Studies and the Dean, Students' Welfare, under the Chairmanship of the Registrar, will also be responsible for maintaining liaison with the nearby hospitals in respect of handling medical emergencies concerning the students.
- (5) Cleaning and sanitization of class rooms and wash rooms of every department under each Faculty will be undertaken frequently and on a regular basis under the guidance of the respective Deans / Head of the respective departments.
- (6) In addition to the University Ambulance, a small vehicle will always be there (24 x 7) at Mohanpur campus as a standby arrangement in respect of handling medical and electrical emergencies.
- (7) The FMTTI building will be reserved as a COVID Isolation Centre in respect of boys and the University Guest House will be reserved as a COVID Isolation Centre in respect of girl students.
- (8) The students would be asked to join hostels in a phased manner, as per schedule mentioned in Notification No. REG/3/L-439 dated 08.11.2021.
- (9) Before entry into the campus the students should be required to give declaration in respect of their Covid vaccination status, their general health condition, etc. in a proforma to be prepared by the Assistant Medical Officer, BCKV.
- (10) In general the entry of outsiders inside the Campus would be restricted, as far as feasible.
- (11) All facilities including supply of sprayer, sanitizer (both hand & room), thermal gun, mask, PPE kit, testing kit and arrangement of isolation, when so needed, will be made available and monitored by a medical team under the leadership of Dr. K. Chatterjee, Assistant Medical Officer. This team will also arrange for banner, pamphlet, festoon, poster and other display materials in respect maintaining COVID safety protocols.
- (12) There will be thermal checking and sanitization facility at every entry point of all establishments, including students' hostels.
- (13) In the event of any Covid suspect getting identified, the person concerned should be thoroughly checked by the University Medical Team and on being confirmed, be immediately isolated and the guardian /family of the concerned student would be informed to take away their ward at their own arrangement within 24 hrs of information.
- (14) The Associate Deans of the two Colleges of Agriculture at Burdwan and Bankura are requested to take the necessary steps at the Colleges in accordance with the guidelines stated above.
