RICE (Harvesting)	Harvesting Stage: 1.Immediately harvesting, threshing, sundrying should be completed at 80% maturity and transfer to safe place, otherwise due to Norwester shattering loss will take place. 2.Do not practice stubble burning. 3.Follow the practice of deep summer ploughing in harvested boro paddy field. 4.Collect the seed of dhaincha and sow the seed @3-4kg/bigha.			
JUTE (Sowing)	Early vegetative stage: 1. Those who have sown the crop between last week of March to first week of April (crop age,4 weeks); apply one light irrigation followed by mechanical weeding. After weeding and thinning, apply top			

dressing of Nitrogen fertilizer @20kg/ha in medium and high fertile soil (20 DAS). In case of low fertile soil apply Nitrogen @ 27kg/ha. For post emergence grass weed control, go for chemical spraying. 2. Maintain proper drainage system.
