Sub: Admission to Master Degree Programmes for the session 2020-21

Applications are invited from Indian citizens only for admission to Master Degree Programmes (2-Years) of Bidhan Chandra Krishi Viswavidyalaya (BCKV) at Mohanpur Campus for the academic session 2020-21. Interested candidates may apply for admission to the Master degree programmes through online mode. Link will be available in university website (www.bckv.edu.in).

(1) ALLOTMENT OF SEATS: As per Annexure-I

All the Master's Degree seats, excepting the ICAR seats will be filled up in the following manner:

- (i) Eighty percent (80%) of the seat in each department of the general category which may be rounded off to nearer absolute number will be reserved for domicile candidates of West Bengal that will be filled up on the basis of merit list.
- (ii) Twenty percent (20%) seats of the general category in each department which may be rounded off to nearer absolute number will be filled up on the basis of merit list considering both domicile and non-domicile candidates. No benefit of reservation will be extended to the non-domicile candidates.
- (iii) In case the seat has fallen vacant due to non-availability of domicile candidates, it will be filled up by the non-domicile candidates on the basis of merit list.
- (iv) ICAR's nominees will be considered as per prevailing rules.

(A) Faculty of Agriculture:

1) Agronomy, 2) Plant Pathology, 3) Agril. Entomology, 4) Agril. Economics, 5) Agril. Statistics, 6) Agril. Extension, 7) Genetics & Plant Breeding, 8) Seed Science & Technology, 9) Plant Physiology, 10) Agril. Chem. & Soil Science, 11) Agril. Biochemistry, 12) Agril. Chemicals, 13) Agril. (4) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:**(A) Agriculture and Horticulture (M.Sc.):**

- (i) Candidates must have passed the 4-year Bachelor Degree examination in Agriculture/ Horticulture. General and OBC candidates must secure Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of at least 6.50/10.00 in ten-point scale whereas for SC/ST candidates, the said requirement is at least 5.50/10.00 in ten-point scale. In traditional system where grade-points are not awarded, the General and OBC category candidates must have secured at least 60 % marks whereas for SC/ST categories, the requirement is at least 50 % marks.
- (ii) Candidates must have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination (10+2) in General stream or Vocational stream securing at least 50 % marks in aggregate for General and OBC categories, whereas for the candidate under SC/ST categories the said requirement is at least 40 %.
- (iii) **No candidate who might have obtained his or her Bachelor Degree from any University where the concerned Faculty /College/ Programme is not accredited by ICAR or State Government aided shall be eligible for admission to Master Degree programme.**
- (iv) Applicants having bachelor degree from other University or college will have to produce a certificate from appropriate authority mentioning that his / her Faculty/ college is either ICAR-accredited or State Government aided before taking admission/ reporting failing which the candidature will be liable to be cancelled.
- (v) All the candidates are required to submit the photocopy of all the transcripts at the time of Counseling/reporting for admission.

(B) Agricultural Engineering (M.Tech.):

- (i) Candidates must have passed the 4-year Bachelor Degree examination in Agricultural Engineering. General and OBC candidates must secure Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of at least 6.50/10.00 in ten-point scale, whereas for SC/ST candidates the said requirement is at least 5.50/10.00 in ten-point scale. In traditional system where grade-points are not awarded, the General and OBC category candidates must have secured at least 60 % marks, whereas for SC/ST categories the requirement is at least 50 % marks.
- (ii) Candidates must have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination (10+2) with subjects and minimum marks of 45 % for general and OBC candidates and 40% for SC/ST candidates.
- (iii) The graduates of some other disciplines of Engineering are also eligible to apply in the respective departments, i.e. 1) Mechanical Engineering for the Dept. of Farm Machinery & Power, 2) Chemical/ Biochemical Engineering for the Dept. of Food Engineering.
- (iv) **No candidate who might have obtained his or her Bachelor Degree from any University where the concerned Faculty/College/Programme is not approved by AICTE or State Government aided shall be eligible for admission to Master Degree programme.**
- (v) Applicants having bachelor degree from other University or college will have to produce a certificate from appropriate authority mentioning that his / her Faculty/ college/ Programme is either AICTE approved or State Government aided before taking admission/ reporting failing which the candidature will be liable to be cancelled.
- (vi) All the candidates are required to submit the photocopy of all the transcripts at the time of Counseling/reporting for admission.

- (5) **IN-SERVICE CANDIDATE:** There shall be one additional seat reserved in each department for in-service candidate. In-Service candidates should have at least three years service experience in a Govt. recognized organization/Institute/University. **Admission of the in-service candidates for Master Degree Programme will be made on the basis of merit list.**

The in-Service candidate must submit a “**NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE**” from his/ her present employer at the time of reporting. After admission, the concerned students must have to submit an approved letter of leave for a period of 2 years issued by his/her employer within two (2) months from the date of reporting, failing which his/her admission will be treated as cancelled without any further notification.

- (6) **CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION:** If it is found at any stage that a candidate has obtained admission by misrepresentation and/or suppression of facts, his/her admission shall be liable to be cancelled.

- (7) **MODE OF APPLICATION (ONLINE) AND PAYMENT OF FEES (ONLINE ONLY):** Apply online through the Viswavidyalaya website (www.bckv.edu.in) and application fee is to be paid as per the following rates. **Application fees once paid will not be refunded.**

In one application, a candidate applying for master's degree programme can give choice of maximum five subjects of Agriculture and Horticulture and 3 subjects of Agricultural Engineering. The candidates have to apply separately paying prescribed application fees if he / she wants to give choice for more than five (5) subjects of Agriculture and Horticulture

- b) **Address:** Permanent Address and address for Correspondence.

- (10) **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AS FOLLOWS FOR UPLOADING AT THE TIME OF FILLING UP ONLINE APPLICATION FORM OF THE CANDIDATE:**

Passport size colour photograph, Scanned signature, Age proof certificate (Birth Certificate/Certificate of Secondary Examination), Mark Sheets [Secondary Examination (10th standard) [Both Side], H.S. Examination /H.S. (Vocational Examination) [10+2 Standard] [Both Side], Bachelor's Degree (4-Years Degree Course)] [Both Side], Caste Certificate (if any), AADHAAR Card.

- (11) **GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ON-LINE APPLICATION FORM:** Display in homepage at the time of on-line application.

- (12) **MERIT LIST WILL BE PREPARED ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING WEIGHTAGE**

An additional 10% weightage over total academic mark will be given to the BCKV pass out students.	

(13) SUBMISSION OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS BY THE CANDIDATE AT THE TIME OF REPORTING (AS UPLOADED AT THE TIME OF ONLINE APPLICATION): Candidates are hereby directed to produce the photocopy of the following documents (as uploaded) along with ORIGINALS for verification at the time of Reporting/Admission:

- (i) The Mark-sheets/Grade Cards of Examination: Secondary Examination (10th Standard), H.S. Examination (10+2 Standard), Bachelor's Degree (4-Years Degree Course) [Both Side]
- (ii) Age-proof certificate [Birth Certificate/ Certificate of Secondary Examination (10th Standard)].
- (iii) SC/ST/PC & OBC-A & OBC-B certificates from the competent authority.
- (iv) Domicile certificate issued by the competent authority (Chairman/ Executive Officer of the Municipality/ Commissioner of Municipal Corporation /Pradhan, Gram Panchayat /B.D.O./ S.D.O.).
- (v) AADHAAR card of the candidate.
- (vi) Two (2) copies of recent colour passport size photograph.
- (vii) Self-attested copy of valid medical certificate from the appropriate authority (Sub-Divisional Medical Officer, Superintendent of State Hospital or above category) **for physically challenged candidates.**

(14) BLOOD ELECTROPHORESIS (THALASSAEMIA) TEST REPORT: The candidates who are admitted after offline / online counseling are required to submit self attested copy of Blood Electrophoresis (Thalassaemia) test report to the Medical Officer, BCKV at the time of reporting.

(15) ANTI-RAGGING DECLARATION: Anti-ragging declaration in the form of affidavit (format to be downloaded from the university Website) would be required to be signed by the admitted candidates and their guardians and to be submitted to the Dean Students' Welfare on the date of reporting for classes/ date of reporting for hostel. Only after receipt of anti-ragging declaration, the University registration certificate will be issued to the admitted candidates.

(16) Canvassing in any form will lead to the disqualification.

❖ **Special Attention:** The merit list will be generated based on the marks provided by the applicants in the online admission form. The merit list, **counselling and/or reporting schedule**, will be displayed on the Notice Board of the Admission and Scholarship Section at Mohanpur campus and also in the university website. Admission will be made only on the basis of merit list following a process of counselling. **On the day of reporting, candidates who will be found eligible after verification of documents with the data provided in the Admission Form, will only be allowed to take final admission.**
